Dear Mr. Doyle:

L&P Plastics does have an active Waste Minimization Plan, Hazardous Waste Contingency Plan and Storm Water Pollution and Prevention Plan that allows us to be environmentally conscious and has allowed us to regain our Small Quantity Waste Generator status from the Illinois EPA.

L&P Plastics is a UL and ISO9001:2000 certified injection molder. Parts with UL certification are allowed to have up to 25% Recycled Material in their content. Humanscale's products do not fall under the scope of our UL certification, but the management philosophy of using recycled material remains the same for all parts we produce regardless. Use of recycled material is of benefit to the environment, manufacturer and customer. It prevents landfill and allows for cost structures to remain low to allow for a competitive price for the customer. The Recycled Material used to manufacture your seating components is all Post-Industrial material.

The resin content of the parts we sell to Humanscale have a recycled content generally based upon the type resin used. Here's a synopsis;

1. ABS – no more than 5% post industrial reclaim based upon regrind of sprues and runners.
2. Polypropylene's – no more than 8% post industrial reclaim based upon reprocessing sprues and runners.
3. 35% Glass fiber filled Nylon 6 – fibers are 100% PIR, resin base is 30-33% PIR based upon average content supplied by resin manufacturer and our own regrind process for sprues and runners. Total expected average of 65-68% PIR
4. Nylon 6 w/glass and mineral filler – 27% PIR based upon regrind process and glass fiber that is 100% PIR.
